1. Rules

This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024)

2. Eligibility and Entry

The event is open to Laser / ILCA sailboats. Entrants must fill out a registration form and pay the registration fees.

3. Fees and Registration

Regatta Entry Fees:

\$40.00 (early registration - through August 25th) \$50.00 (late registration - after August 25th)*

Please register using the USC Website (<u>www.unionsailingclub.org</u>) prior to the regatta.

Entry fee does not include mandatory Union Reservoir Park vehicle or boat passes, which are available at the park entry station.




5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instruction will be posted on the USC Website (www.unionsailingclub.org) at least 1 week prior to the event. Sailing Instructions take precedence of this NOR.

6. Regatta Site

The regatta site will be at Union Sailing Club on the south-eastern shore of Union Reservoir, Longmont, Colorado. Launching at USC is by dolly only, no vehicles are allowed on the gravel launch ramps. Any boats being brought on site must report to the Union Reservoir Park main gate to be inspected for Aquatic Nuisance Species (ANS) by the Park staff prior to launching. This applies to all boats, even those launched at the USC dolly-only ramps.





7. Racing Area and Courses

Racing area and courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Scoring

The scoring system will be the Low Point Scoring System found in Appendix A of the RSS. One race is required to be completed to constitute a Regatta. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of Page 2 of 3 her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Awards

Awards will be issued for the top 3 competitors overall, top Master, top Junior competitor and top Female competitor. If 3 or more ILCA 6 / Laser Radial boats are registered, an award for top ILCA 6 competitor will be awarded.

Junior : Under 19 years old* Master : Over 44 years old*
