COVID-19 Policy July 23, 2020

1. Everyone on Union Sailing Club grounds must follow all relevant State of Colorado, Weld County, Boulder County, City of Longmont, and Union Reservoir Park guidelines for COVID-19.
2. Always bring a **face covering** with you to wear while on club grounds. Everyone is to **social distance** themselves from non-household members at all times. Face masks must be worn while on shore, when within 6 feet of a non-household member.
3. The barge is to only be used by one family group at a time. Members are not permitted to **congregate in groups** on club grounds.
4. The docks may be used to launch and retrieve boats only. When launching and retrieving, please be sure to **socially distance** yourself from other sailors using the docks.
5. Only one boat is allowed on the ramp to launch or retrieve at a time, except in the case of a sudden storm, heavy wind or other emergency. Ensure that social distancing is maintained at all times.
6. Please use restrooms with caution. A hand washing station is available for member use. Please bring sanitizing wipes to wipe down touched surfaces after using the restroom.
7. Members of different households may sail together in double-handers, provided they are wearing **adequate face coverings**.
8. Sailboats, paddle boards and kayaks are not to be left unattended on the beach area to reduce congregation and congestion. Sailors are to make use of the full width of the beach area to park dollies.
9. In the case of inclement weather, members are to shelter in their vehicles. The sheds are off limits.
10. It is highly recommended that **PFDs** be worn while on the water.
11. Do not visit the club if you suspect or know you, or a family member, have COVID-19. To reduce the risk of exposing other members, do not visit the club until you have been symptom free for at least 2 weeks. Please inform a member of the board if you have tested positive for COVID-19 and have visited the club while contagious.
12. No non-member guests are allowed to visit the club at this time, except in the case where a single non-member guest is helming or crewing for an existing member. Social gatherings are not permitted on club grounds.
