### 1. Schedule of Events

*Saturday, October 1, 2016*

09:30 to 10:15 - Registration at USC clubhouse / doughnuts and coffee

10:30 - Skippers meeting at the clubhouse

11:25 - Warning signal for first race, additional races to follow. *No race will be started after 17:00*

ASAP after last race - Trophy presentation & BBQ Potluck (burgers, hot dogs, and drinks will be provided, please bring something to share, if possible)

### 2. Rules

This Regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016.

### 3. Eligibility and Entry

The event is open to Multihulls and One Design dinghies that register and pay the fees. Boats racing One Design shall comply with their One Design Class rules. Three boats will make a fleet. Anticipated fleets are Multi-hulls, MCs, Snipes, Mutineers, Lasers, Sunfish, and Butterflies.

### 4. Fees

Regatta Entry Fee for double-handed boats: \$25.00

Regatta Entry Fee for single-handed boats: \$20.00

Entry fees do not include vehicle, park, or boat passes which are available at the clubhouse or the park entry station.

### 5. IMPORTANT NOTES

All boats trailered in for the regatta MUST have a Zebra Mussel inspection at the Park Entrance Station before being launched at either the City or the Club ramp.

The launch ramps at the Club are for dollies only, no trailer launching.

### 8. Regatta Site

### 9. Racing Area and Courses

Racing area and courses will be as shown on the Union Sailing Club Race Course Chart, available at registration.

### 10. Scoring

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016 will be used. All races will be scored.

### 11. Trophies

Fleets with three to five boats will be awarded first and second place trophies. Fleets with six or more boats will be awarded first, second and third place trophies.
